Using, in many cases, previously unpublished accounts of the soldiers on the ground this book follows Britain's 79th Armored Division, Sir Percy Hobart's 'Funnies', as they utilized their unique weaponry in support of Allied efforts to ensure the success of the invasion. The author draws on British, American, Canadian and German sources.
