They focus on building bonds between dedicated community organizations and passionate individuals. Many people in a community care deeply for their neighbors and town and may not know the outlets or initiatives they can use to give back. Hodge and Franz provide step-by-step instructions for identifying vulnerable areas in a community and building an action plan and organization to address them.
